<p>Tyre Importer</p> 	<p>You are an organisation which imports tyres into NZ.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - New tyre importers - Used tyre importers (includes casings) - New vehicle importers - Used vehicle importers 	<p>YES</p> <p>'The Tyrewise Fee' is captured for all tyres at the first point of importation or registration.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fee for loose tyres included in customs payments - Fee for tyres on all vehicles collected by NZTA at first registration 	<p>NO</p>	<p>All importers would be mandated to contribute to an accredited stewardship scheme (such as Tyrewise) under the Waste Minimisation Act 2008 Priority Product legislation.</p> <p>Importers may be able to claim rebates if the tyres they import fall outside of eligibility criteria for a stewardship programme (e.g. mobility scooter tyres).</p>
<p>Consumer</p> 	<p>You are 'Joe Public'.</p> <p>When you buy new tyres you need to get rid of the old ones. OR You may have old tyres for other reasons that you need to get rid of.</p>	<p>NO</p> <p>The cost of the programme is built into the price of all new tyres This is called 'The Tyrewise fee'.</p>	<p>NO</p> <p>You do not get any money for recycling your tyres.</p>	<p>Landfills will no longer accept tyres.</p> <p>You must recycle your tyres via a registered collection site, or you can leave them with the company that fitted your new tyres.</p> <p>AND</p> <p>Any inappropriate dumping of tyres will result in fines and/or prosecution.</p>
<p>Generator</p> 	<p>You are either:</p> <p>A tyre seller and/or fitter who takes old tyres when you sell new ones</p> <p>OR</p> <p>A large user of tyres & your tyres are replaced on-site</p>	<p>NO</p> <p>Any tyres that you take from your customers are collected for free.</p>	<p>NO</p> <p>You should not charge customers for taking their old tyres. (but remember you don't have to pay to have them collected either)</p>	<p>If tyres are a Priority Product this means that you will need to register with Tyrewise as a condition of selling/fitting tyres.</p> <p>If you sell or fit any tyres, you MUST be prepared to take the used tyres from your customer for disposal.</p> <p>These tyres can either be kept by you for collection, or taken to a Collection Site.</p> <p>Your may be asked by Tyrewise to provide auditable reports on the volume of tyres that you accept.</p>
<p>Collection Site</p> 	<p>You are a place where Consumers and/or Generators can drop off unwanted tyres if they aren't purchasing new ones (such as a transfer station)</p>	<p>NO</p> <p>Any tyres that you collect at your site are picked up for free.</p>	<p>YES</p> <p>Collection sites are paid a nominal service fee by Tyrewise to act as aggregation points for tyres to be collected.</p> <p>Payments are on a sliding scale (Very busy sites would get paid more than small sites)</p>	<p>You must be registered with Tyrewise as an approved Collection Site.</p> <p>Your may be asked by Tyrewise to provide auditable reports on your collection volumes.</p> <p>A Generator could also act as a Collection Site and aggregate tyres for Customers and other Generators.</p>
<p>Transporter</p> 	<p>You collect tyres from Generators and/or Collection Sites and deliver them to Processors</p>	<p>NO</p> <p>All tyres are collected at no charge to the Generator or Collection site.</p>	<p>YES</p> <p>Tyrewise pays you for the tyres you deliver to a Processor.</p>	<p>You must be registered with Tyrewise as an approved Transporter.</p> <p>So you get paid, you must have a contractual relationship with a Processor / Manufacturer to accept the tyres.</p> <p>Your may be asked by Tyrewise to provide auditable reports on your transported volumes.</p>
<p>Processor</p> 	<p>You transform the tyres in some way so that they can be put to a good end-use.</p>	<p>YES</p> <p>You may pay Transporters to deliver the tyres you need.</p> <p>(This is for you to negotiate - Tyrewise does not get involved.)</p>	<p>YES</p> <p>In addition to money you make from selling your products, Tyrewise makes a payment per kg of tyres processed and supplied/sold to a Manufacturer.</p> <p>The level of payment depends on what your tyre derived product is eventually used for.</p>	<p>You must provide evidence of the Manufacturers' end-use for the processed material in order to receive payments from Tyrewise.</p> <p>Your reports may be subject to audit by Tyrewise in order to ensure the subsidy is being paid correctly.</p>
<p>Manufacturer</p> 	<p>You purchase tyre derived products from a Processor to use in your business (such as for fuel or as an ingredient for a new product).</p> <p>NOTE: If you purchase whole tyres directly from a Transporter you would be classified as a Processor as well as a Manufacturer.</p>	<p>YES</p> <p>Typically you would pay a Processor a market price for the products.</p> <p>(This is for you to negotiate - Tyrewise does not get involved)</p>	<p>YES</p> <p>Tyrewise pays you for the tyre derived product you use in manufacturing.</p>	<p>You will need to provide Tyrewise with evidence of what you use the tyre derived products for. This is because it affects the payments made to you by Tyrewise.</p>
